CHRISTCHURCH IS SOLARPEAK FOCUSED

This home has 3 bedrooms and a self contained flat, it combines a 350 litre mains pressure Superheat twin element cylinder and a 40 tube S o lar P e a k. The dishwasher is an Asko and is fed with hot water rather than cold to avoid the element doing all the work.

Solar Ready

At a pitch of 40 degrees due North this system is well designed to classify as an A grade hot water system.



This 4 bedroom home combines 40 tubes with a solar ready superheat twin element cylinder.Again a dishwasher and washing machine gets it's hot water from this system.



An executive multi leveled home combines 40 tubes retrofitted to a 350 litre external cylinder together with a 6 kW photoelectric system grid tied giving the owners a very sophisticated energy system



A farm Villa combines a SolarPeak 30 tube to a Peter Cox 300 litre cylinder to a Lady Kitchener 5 kW wetback. A SolarPeak 4.0kW system also feeds the grid.
